









Corona, 2020 Charcoal on paper 160 x 250 cm, (Based on Sirigatti's Perspective Manual from the Renaissance)



Boat, 2014 Charcoal on paper 70 x 100 cm




Void Fraction, 2014 Charcoal on paper 160 x 300 cm (Based on a SEM microscope image of a porous ceramic material)
